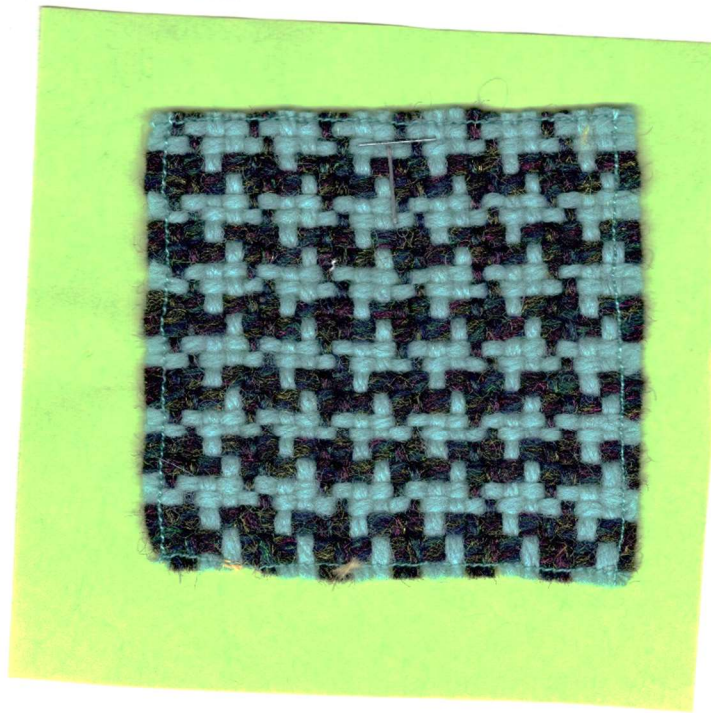
8 dent reed -- single sley

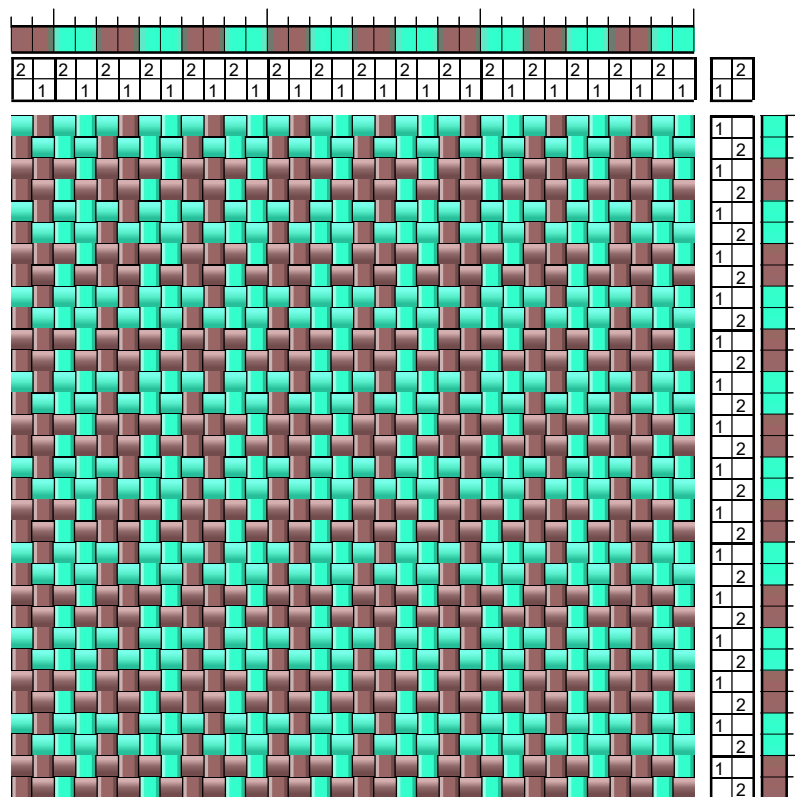
Warp: Knitting Worsted Weight -- two colors

Weft: Same as warp.

Treadling: 1 then 2 X  
1 then 2 O
